This Union Believes:

- 1. All students have the right to feel safe and comfortable on campus
- 2. Facilities on campus should feel accessible to all students
- 3. Trans*, non-binary and Gender Non-Conforming students are welcome and valued members of Central's community

This Union Further Believes:

- 1. Increasing the number of gender-neutral toilets is a valuable measure in making Trans*, non-binary and GNC people feel safer and more comfortable at Central.
- 2. Trans*, non-binary and GNC students have the right to express their identity freely and without scrutiny
- 3. The Accessible Toilets functioning as the only Gender-Neutral toilets on campus is not a viable substitute and is detrimental to those with access needs.

This Union Resolves:

- 1. To work to increase the number of available Gender-Neutral toilets on campus
- 2. To campaign to update the signage on some single-gender toilets to allow for more gender-neutral facilities
- 3. To continue to work to provide sanitary products available in gender-neutral toilets, as well as female toilets.
